A590 Backbarrow Gateways - pedestrian crossing improvements

We're writing to inform you that we'll shortly be starting work on the A590 at Backbarrow.

Our work involves installing new safety signs, pedestrian presence sensors and new road studs. The aim of the scheme is to enhance safety for pedestrians using the crossing, while also improving signage for road users.

To enable us to safely carry out our work we'll be installing temporary traffic signals, which will be in place throughout the scheme. Work is set to start at <u>7pm Monday 21 March 2022</u> for around 7 weeks.

We'll be carrying out our work overnight, working from 7pm Monday until 6am Saturday. We will not be working at weekends and all traffic management will be removed ahead of the bank holidays.

Our work can be noisy, but we'll be following industry best practice to reduce it as much as possible. Nonetheless, we'd like to apologise in advance for any disturbance this may cause you.

We always aim to work to schedule, but unforeseen circumstances, such as bad weather, mean slight changes can occur at short notice.

Brow Edge Road residents - vehicle access

While the traffic management is in place, vehicle access to your properties will remain as normal. However, when leaving your property please await instruction from a marshal to ensure you pass safely through the traffic management.
